I/We understand that Massey University will:

- Visit the home of the designated caregiver prior to offer of place to determine that the living conditions are of an acceptable standard.
- Assess whether the designated caregiver will provide a safe physical and emotional environment for the student.
- Determine that the accommodation is not a boarding establishment (ie does not have five or more international students staying in the home). If the accommodation designated by the parents is a boarding establishment then the student will be required to be placed in Massey University-approved homestay accommodation.
- Meet with the designated caregiver and maintain regular communication with the designated caregiver.
- Require Police Vetting to be undertaken on all adults over the age of 18 years living in the household.

- Meet the student at least quarterly. Two interviews to take place at Massey University, and two visits to take place at the designated caregiver's home to ensure the accommodation is suitable. Massey University will provide a report to the student's parents after each visit and interview.

Should this arrangement change I/we undertake to inform Massey University immediately.

I/we understand that Massey University will make every endeavour to ensure the safety and welfare of my/our child while studying at Massey University. Should there be a concern about the welfare of my/our child, Massey University's Accommodation and Welfare staff will discuss the concern with the designated caregiver/s and parents of the student. I/we understand that should Massey University have any concerns regarding the welfare of my/our child, then Massey University may relocate the student to a Massey University-approved homestay. If necessary, Massey University will also refer the matter to the relevant welfare authorities or any other appropriate outside agencies.
